

Response to amending the NTC Interim Methodology on French-Great Britain Interconnectors

Brussels, 24 August 2026

Key messages

We welcome the opportunity to engage with RTE on cross-border subjects with Great Britain; we recognise and emphasise the value of well-functioning interconnectors. We support the proposed amendment that would allow RTE to increase the capacity available after D-3 when justified. We believe this is a positive development, as it would enhance transparency and make additional capacity available to the market.

Additional cross-border capacity is generally beneficial, as it promotes a more efficient use of interconnection capacity and creates additional trading opportunities for market participants.

As a general rule, we appreciate the consultative process and consistent transparency on any restrictions/limitations to capacity that are put in place. Furthermore, predictability is essential. Market participants need sufficient visibility regarding capacity revisions, as well as reliable and timely information, in order to anticipate their commercial positions and portfolio optimisation activities.

Finally, we see an opportunity to improve the publication and dissemination of capacity-related information. More user-friendly and accessible communication tools would enhance transparency and help market participants integrate capacity updates more effectively into their operational and commercial decision-making. In this regard, we encourage a more modern approach to data publication, drawing inspiration from practices implemented by NESO in Great Britain.
